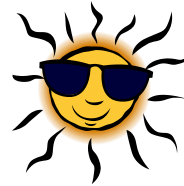


Oakfield Summer Recreation

Hello Again Everyone,

I am pleased to say that I will again be the director of the Summer Recreation Program for the 2010 season. Last year proved to be a relatively successful one, and I am looking to build on that success this year with some new and exciting opportunities and adventures. We have four returning counselors and have added two new who will fit in very nicely with the direction the program is heading in. Field trips are always a highlight to the summer and we will be taking a hand full of them again this summer. This time we will be going to a couple new and exciting locations (more information will be handed out during the first week).

I am also excited to announce that we will be teaming up with the Pembroke Recreation Program to offer recreational swimming and swim instruction with trained lifeguards and instructors to ensure the safety of all participants. The children will be split up into two different groups K-3 and 4-6 for swim time. While they are not swimming we will be doing activities in the gymnasium of the high school. This will take place every week on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30 – 11:30. On these days we will meet at the high school NOT at the park (No counselors will be at the park).



Lastly I'd like to emphasize our commitment to security and safety. Again, like last year, we will be implementing a sign/sign out procedure. This will require that the person picking up the child must provide a valid ID. After we get into a routine and know names and faces, an ID will be mandatory only for unfamiliar people. No student may leave the program without a registered adult or written consent!!!



THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- When: July 5th – August 6 (Monday-Friday 9-4)
- Where: Oakfield Town Park – Drake Street
- Who Can Come: must be at least 6 years old or have completed kindergarten, The program is intended for children 6-13 years of age. Inappropriate behavior will NOT be tolerated by any children under any circumstances!
- Lunch or money for pizza at Little League stand
- Sunscreen
- Bathing Suit, Towel and Change of clothes (Tuesdays and Thursdays)
- Something to drink
- We remain open on rainy days
- Permission Slip and money for field trips will be due two days prior to the trip, late slips will not be accepted and the child may not come with us
- Park is closed days of Field Trips
- Please fill out and return the registration form on the next page to the Town Hall on Drake Street by July 2nd
